

**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-05**

**ANNEXATION ORDINANCE OF PROPERTY  
THAT IS INHABITED BY LESS THAN THREE VOTERS  
OR IS UNOCCUPIED**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF DAWSON, TEXAS ANNEXING THE  
HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF DAWSON, NAVARRO  
COUNTY, TEXAS, AND EXTENDING THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF SAID CITY SO  
AS TO INCLUDE SAID HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED PROPERTY WITHIN THE  
CITY LIMITS AND BOUNDARIES.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of Dawson, Texas, hereby finds that annexation of the property described in the attached Exhibit A is necessary to protect the boundaries and citizens of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAWSON, TEXAS THAT:

The area and territory described in the attached Exhibit A be officially annexed into the City of Dawson, Navarro County, Texas, be and the same are hereby extended to include the property described in the attached Exhibit A within the city limits of the City of Dawson, Texas and the same shall hereafter be included within the territorial limits of said city, and said land and the future inhabitants thereof shall hereafter be entitled to all rights and privileges of other citizens of the City of Dawson, Texas and shall be bound by the acts and ordinances of said city.

The City Secretary is hereby directed to include this ordinance in the regular minutes, by reference or otherwise, so that the same may be readily accessible; and is further directed to file a copy of this ordinance with the County Clerk of Navarro County, Texas. The City Secretary is further directed to transmit a copy of this ordinance to the Texas Department of Transportation for relocation of City Limits signs, if necessary, and for the correction of plats, maps, etc.
