

Public Notice to Boil Water

For the Post Oak SUD

06/08/2026

Due to a water main break, loss of pressure, the line being opened and repaired with the flow of water; Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required the Post Oak Water System to notify all customers of the need to boil their water prior to consumption.

***The line break was on SW County Road 4010 due to a contractor crew hitting the main line. Customers affected are from SW CR 4010 and south to SW CR 4040 in the Dawson area. Post Oak SUD will be flushing the lines and will notify residents in this area when it is no longer necessary to boil their water.**

To ensure the deconstruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking and making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the boil water notice has ceased.
